RATIONALE & OBJECTIVE

Over 40% of Africa's population lives in extreme poverty, compounded by inadequate healthcare, limited employment opportunities, and underfunded health systems. The African Union projects 1.3 billion young people in Africa by 2050, creating both challenges and opportunities. Community Health Workers (CHWs) are critical in addressing maternal and child mortality by bringing life-saving healthcare closer to communities. Investing in CHWs yields a >10:1 return, with the potential to prevent 2.3 million maternal and child deaths annually.

Objective: Explore a three-pronged approach to strengthening the PHC system and accelerating SDGs 3 & 8:

- 1. Entrepreneurial Opportunities for CHWs: Enabling dignified work in both private and public sectors.
- 2. **Recognized & Gainful Employment:** Recruiting, training, equipping, and remunerating CHWs to promote health & nutrition.
- Enabling Environment & Ecosystem: Gender-transformative policies and sustainable financing for CHWs.
