

Thematic focus	<p>Equitable land rights as a precondition for sustainable economic growth in Africa.</p> <p>This session seeks to re-awaken and re-emphasize the significance of tenure security for realizing the SDGs and Agenda 2063. With the continent's economic growth largely depending on agriculture, land remains a critical factor of production. However, Africa's development remains slow due to the glaring and persistent challenges about tenure regimes across the region, inequalities in access, ownership, and control of land, deeply entrenched social and gender patriarchal norms, and gaps in law and practice of gender-responsive and equitable land governance processes.</p>
