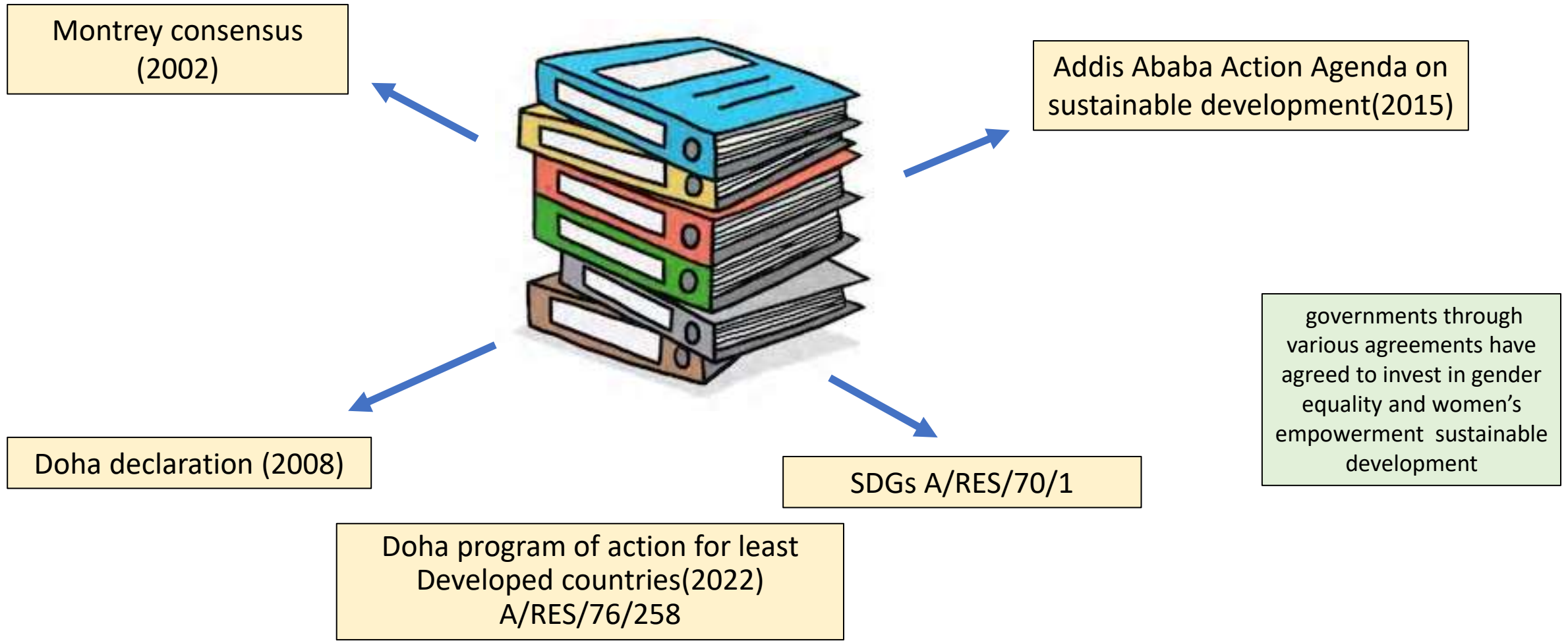

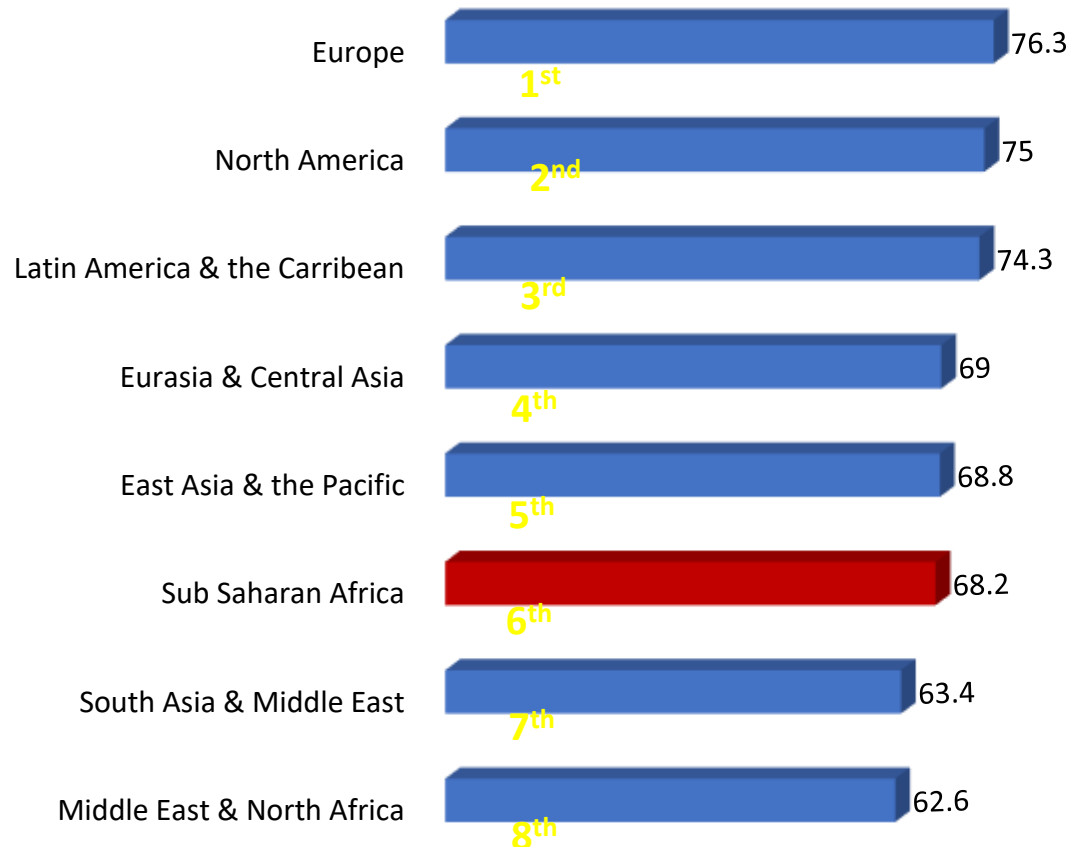

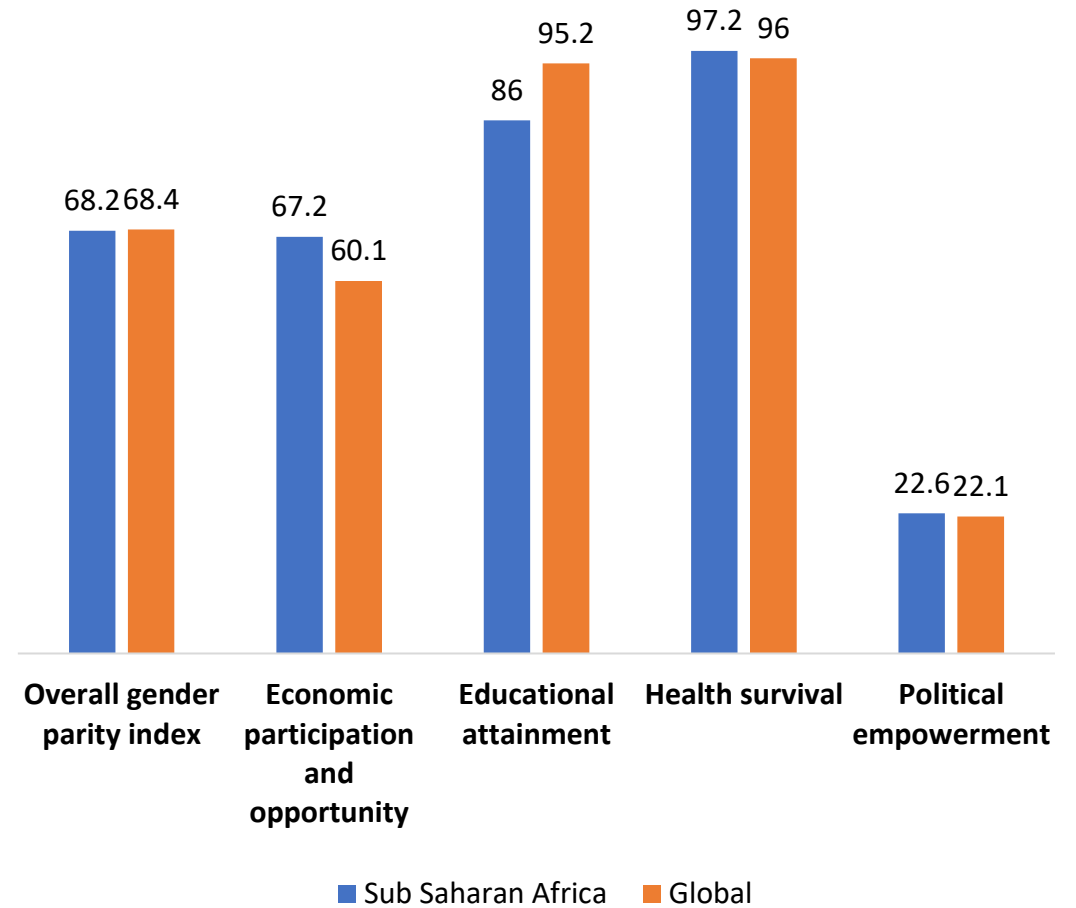


Gender Equality at a Glance: % of gender gap that has been closed (Gender Gap index)

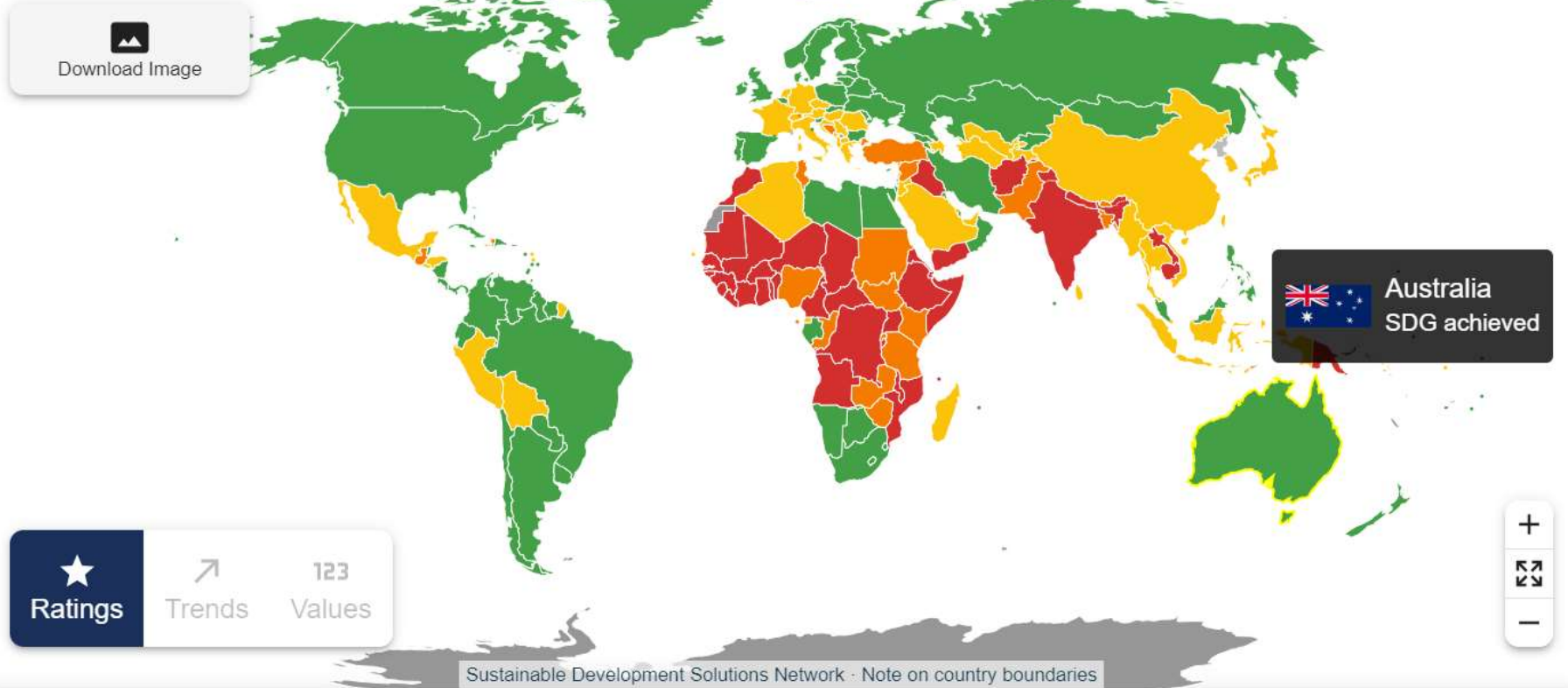
