

Trade is not gender neutral...has different effects on men and women due to existing social, economic and structural inequalities...




Need for gender-responsive policies and targeted interventions, but...





Continental Methodology for ICBT Data Collection in Africa...



Informal cross-border trade (ICBT) refers to transactions in goods and services between any two or more countries that are not entered in the official records and therefore not included in the official trade statistics.

Key findings of ICBT data collection in select border crossings & markets in ECOWAS...

Total value of ICBT recorded during the 4-month data collection period



Disaggregation of the total value of ICBT by gender



Comparison between men and women informal cross-border traders...



Men traded in a wider range of goods (e.g., manufactured goods, beverages, livestock) than women who mostly traded in food items



Continental methodology for ICBT data collection in Africa...



To be piloted in: Cameroon, CAR, Uganda, Tanzania, Algeria, Tunisia, Nigeria and Senegal.
