- **Data value chain**

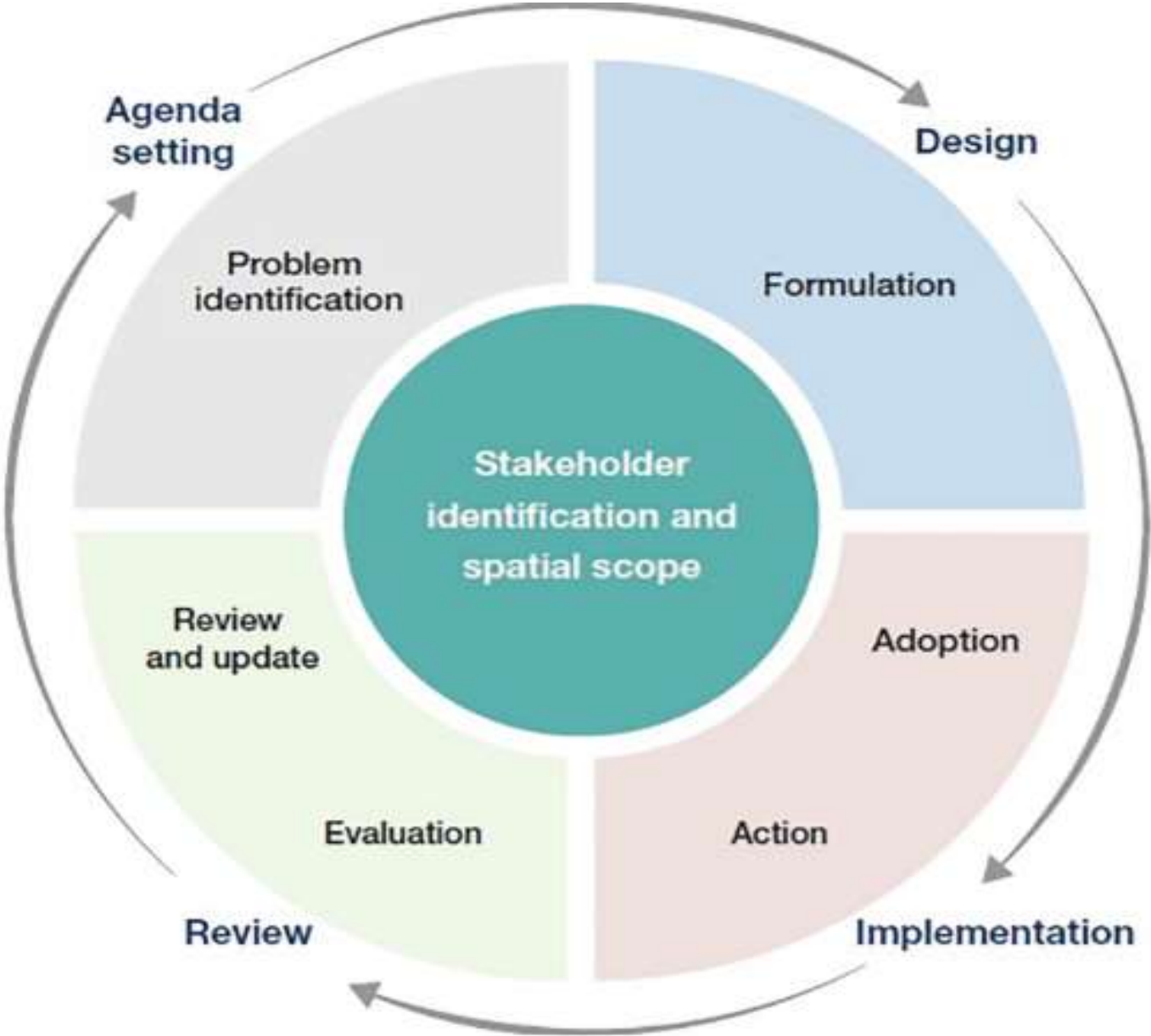
- Data-informed policies are more effective, inclusive and sustainable

- **Gender-Responsive Policymaking** – leads to more equitable and effective policies that address the specific needs and challenges of all genders

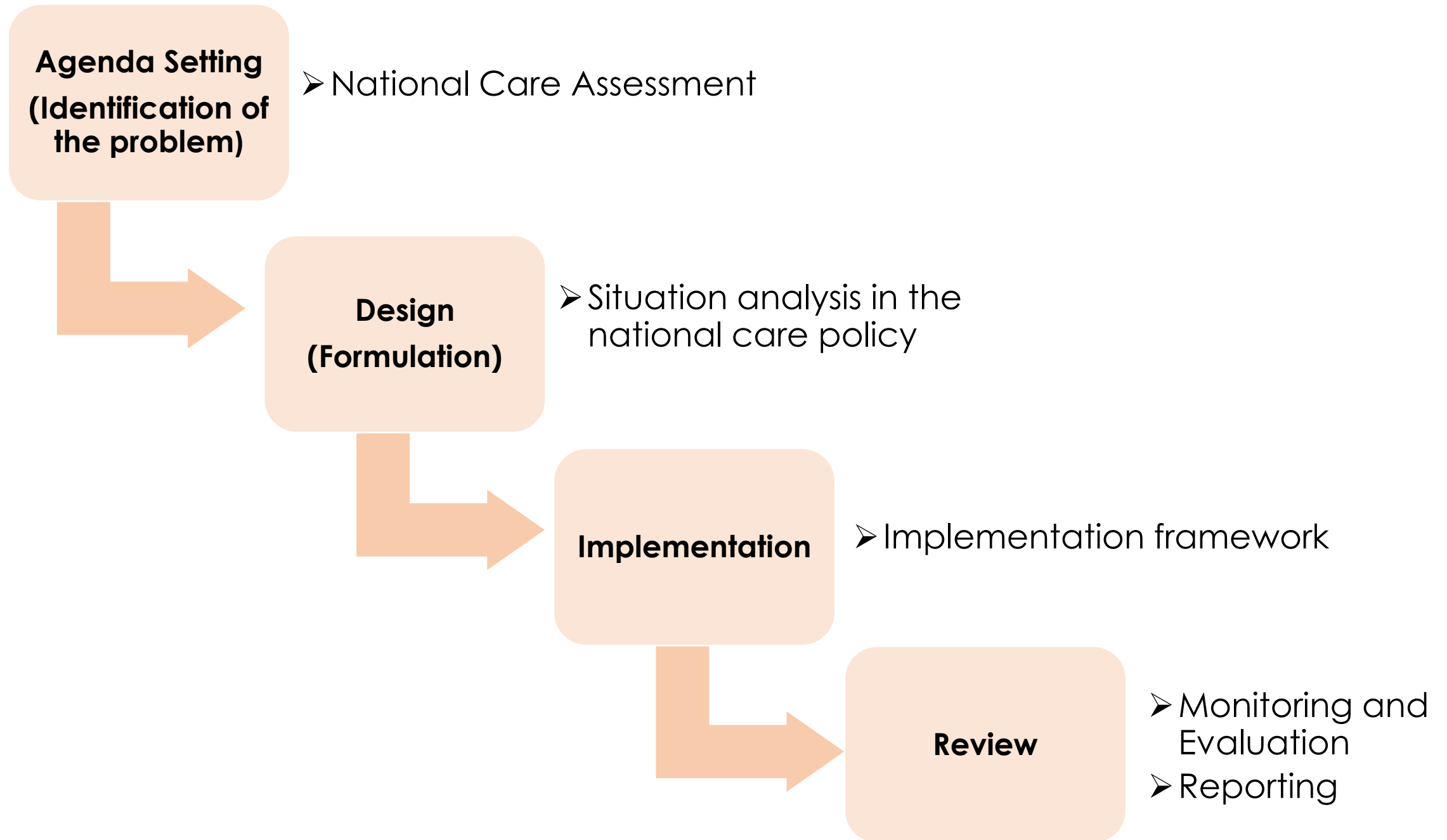
- **Kenya National Care Policy**
