Establishment of the AGGS

Keeping in view the need of a better coordination and harmonization in addressing challenges related to the lack of gender statistics, the Statistical Commission for Africa (STACOM-Africa), in its first meeting in 2008, set up a Working Group on Gender Statistics called African Group on Gender statistics (AGGES)..

The UNECA is the secretariat of the AGGES.

Provide a forum for discussion between key users and producers of statistics

Promote coordination of initiatives and activities on gender statistics;

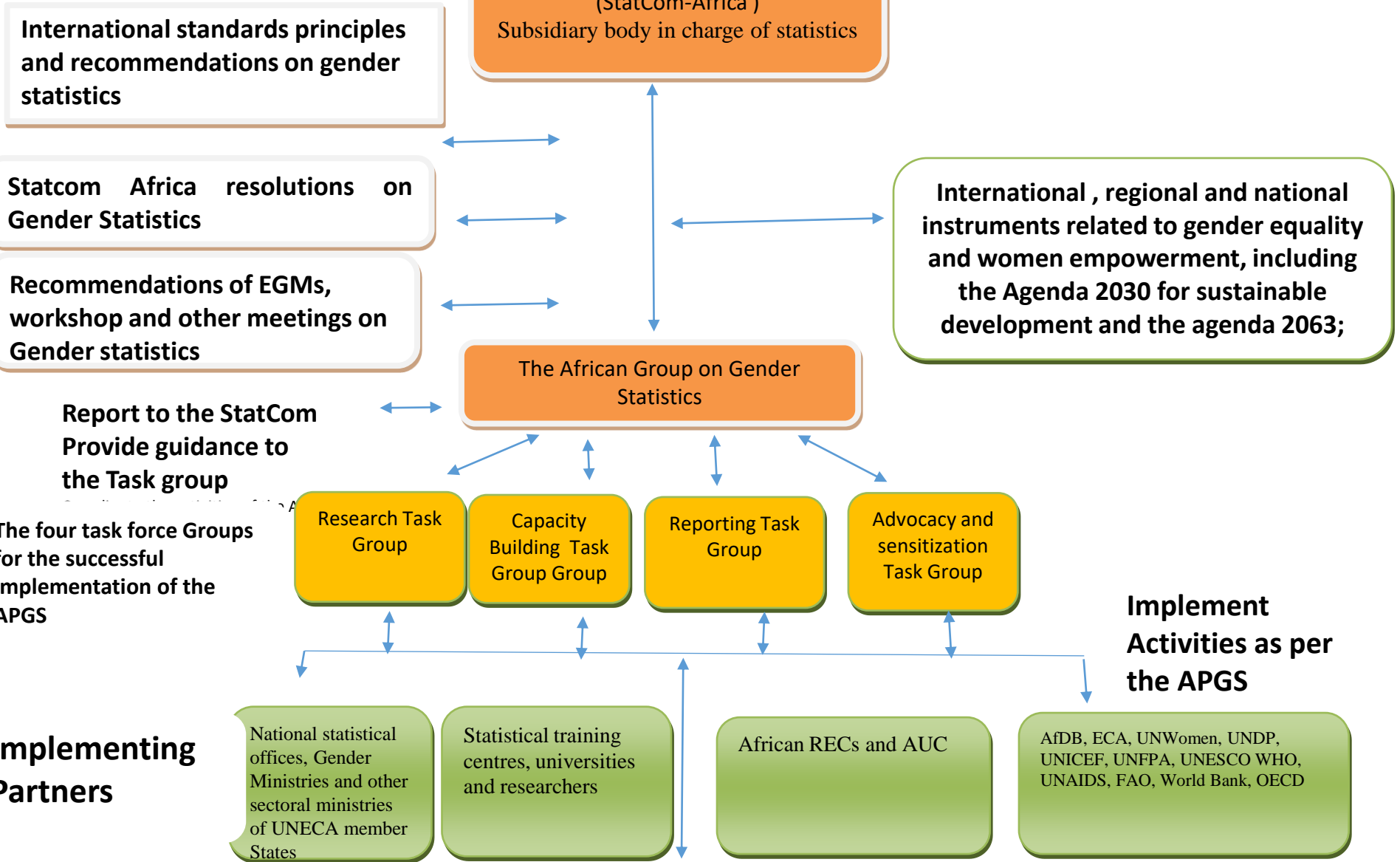
Promote exchange of experiences and foster best practices on gender statistics
