Recommended actions - Financing

- Expand domestic financial resources for gender statistics
- Undertake costing of gender equality interventions to inform realistic estimates of financing requirements.
- Mobilise financial resources for gender statistics through strategic engagement with development partners















Recommended actions - Coordination

- Enhance coordination between Ministries of Planning,
 Finance & Economic Development, Parliamentarians,
 national statistics offices and Ministries of Gender
- Governments to engage National statistical Offices in the Beijing +30 review















Recommended actions – Methodological work

- To refine the gender and trade methodology developed to include formal data to collect sex-disaggregated on trade.
- During the next two years have developed or supported the development of tools and methodologies for the measurement of:
 - Gender data in humanitarian settings
 - Climate change and the environment















Recommended actions – Implementation arrangements

- South-South cooperation
- The need to factor in a gender perspective in NSDS.
- Ensure integration of gender statistics into ongoing work, including in administrative records
- Ensure effective communication approaches for data use.
- Enforcement and effective implementation of programs, strategies, and policies: implement initiatives effectively.
