UN General Assembly declared 2018-2028: The International Decade for Action "Water for Sustainable Development".

Goals of the decade:

- In recognition, access to water and sanitation is a precondition to life, a human right and vitally important to sustainable development.
- Focus on the sustainable development and integrated management of water resources for the achievement of social, economic, and environmental objectives.
- Galvanize the implementation of existing programmes and projects.
- enhance cooperation and partnership at all levels to help achieve internationally agreed water-related goals and targets.
- Inspire actions to achieve the 2030 Agenda.
- In Africa enhanced action to achieve, the AU Agenda 2063, 2030 Agenda, the African Water Vision 2025.

Objectives of Regional Consultative Meeting:

- To assess the midterm progress made by various African countries towards achievement of the targets and goals of the water related Sustainable Development Goals, SDG 6 & its targets.
- To determine options for building and strengthening partnership to accelerate implementation of objectives of Decade of Action for Water.
- To develop a Plan of Action to support countries accelerate actions in 2nd half of the decade and achieve its goals &objectives
- To ensure harmonized approach in presenting Africa's inputs to the Mid-Term Review of International Water Decade; "Water for Sustainable Development" in March 2023.
