

## **OPEN DATA- Strategic Framework**

In January 2014, Tunisia joined the initiative « Open Government Partnership »



multilateral initiative which brings together 80 member countries as well as NGOs and representatives of civil society

**Open Data** is one of the major axes of the national action plans of the **Partnership for Open Government** 



## **OPEN DATA- Strategic Framework**

Tunisia has developed and implemented three national action plans-PGOs which have contributed to establishing the principles of Open Government

A steering committee is set up comprising an equal number of government and civil society representatives

The steering committee is responsible for preparing the action plan and monitoring its implementation

- Preparation of a law on « data reuse »






### management of data with SDMX




#### **SDMX** dissemination platform

- ➤ Put in place the necessary legal Framework for the openning of data
- ➤ Propose harmonization for the reuse of african data

support the production of timely, reliable and harmonized statistics to aid the African integration process and inclusive development at the national, regional and continental levels,



## Roadmap

Creation of an African working group bringing together representatives of NSIs who have already worked on opening up data and representatives of African institutions (AU, ECA and AfDB)

The role of this group will be to develop a roadmap in coordination with the UN WG based on the following axes:

- ➤ Setting up African directives for the openning of data which will be a support for African countries to develop their legal Framework
- ➤ Development of procedural manuals for the establishment of a pratical guide to openning public data
- Setting up of a harmonized interoperability framework in accordance with international standards
- ➤ Development of an African open data portal aiming accessibility and reuse of AU data which can develop to became the single point to access to a grawing range of data produced by African statistical institutions.
- > Provide a commun metadata catalog that can be reused by countries
