Stage of Census Preparation at the Time of Outbreak

- 1. Preparations were well advanced
 - a. Two trial censuses completed
 - b. Training of Master Trainers initiated
 - c. District Census Officers engaged
- 2. Census date is three months away
 - a. Cost implications
 - b. The pandemic can only be monitored
- 3. Options available to carry on with preparatory activities
 - a. Opportunity to catch-up on activities that were lagging behind



COVID-19 Business Continuity Plan (BCP)

- Dynamic Business Continuity Plan
 - Reviewed at all levels of management every other week
- Emergency meeting with the National Census Steering Committee
 - Estimation of the cost implications of postponing the Census
- Teleworking guideline to enable staff to work from home
 - Resources and financial token to incentivize staff to continue working
 - Sustained the engagement of non-permanent staff
- Revision of data collection approaches
 - Review of scope of work
 - Assessment of methodological implications of the changing approaches



Innovative and Pragmatic Statistical Solutions

- Virtual engagement with Trainers
 - Collaboration with academics from four public universities to review methodologies and assess trainers
 - Virtual training and assessment of Master Trainers
 - Development of virtual engagement protocols
- Setting up an interactive dashboard to monitor COVID-19 statistics
 - Data disaggregated to the regional and district levels
 - Highlight hotspots
 - Identify districts with vulnerable populations



Innovative and Pragmatic Statistical Solutions

- Using Call Detail Records for mobility analysis to guide government COVID-19 interventions
 - Collaboration with Flowminder Foundation and Vodafone Ghana
- Launching survey trackers to assess the socio-economic impact of COVID-19
 - Household and jobs survey (3265 households)
 - Business survey (4311 businesses)
 - Local Economy survey (2770 localities)
- Conducting pilot surveys to monitor SDGs
 - Recruitment costs pilot survey measure SDG Indicator 10.7.1
- Collection of monthly CPI data in adherence with safety protocols



Census Implementation in the COVID-19 era

Adherence to safety protocols

- Reduction in class sizes for in-person trainings
- Provision of sanitizers and face masks to Trainers and Field Officers
- Increased Regional collaboration to aid decentralized census operations
 - Weekly virtual meetings with all 16 Regional Statisticians
- Integration of virtual training at all levels
 - It is not an issue of replacement but hybridization
 - Combination of virtual and face-to-face training is cost effective



Census Implementation in the COVID-19 era

•Third trial census needed

- Phased approach to overcome time and resource constraints
- Designed to allow for trial post enumeration survey as well

Pre-certification training course for trainers

- Longer period of engagement with trainers
- Ability to build critical soft skills such as emotional intelligence, classroom management and administration into training content
- Flexibility for trainees and Offline options to mitigate internet connectivity challenges
- Open-up training to include experienced external resource persons in a virtual mode to enhance the engagement
- Standardization of content as trainers at all levels have access to the same learning materials



Census Implementation in the COVID-19 era

- •Testing Protocols using Ghana National Household Registry (GNHR) exercise
 - Piloting COVID-19 health and safety protocols for training and fieldwork
 - Testing of listing instruments and protocols
- Postponement of census provided opportunity for added quality assurance of workstream processes
 - Validation of census maps
 - Review of training materials
 - Updating of workstream strategies and protocols
