2. ECA's Integrated Planning and Reporting Toolkit (IPRT)

- ECA has developed a mainstreaming toolkit, known as Integrated Planning and Reporting Toolkit (IPRT).
- Mandate:
 - The 2016 Conference of Ministers (COM) requested ECA & AUC to develop a tool that helps align multiple development agendas with national development frameworks.

- What is ECA's IPRT?
- A tool that facilitates **alignment** of SDGs and A2063 with national development frameworks.
 - Levels of alignment: goal, target and indicator.
- It also allows for assessing the relationship between different development agendas.
- Assess degree of alignment by sector.

- Track progress in the implementation of SDGs and A2063:
 - Identify gaps between actual performance and targets.
- Progress review reports: Contributions to VNRs for the HLPF.
