

1. Introduction



- African member states have made several **continental** and **global** commitments.
- 2030 Agenda for Sustainable Development Goals
- Agenda 2063;
- The Paris Agreement;
- The Sendai Framework on Disaster Risk Reduction;
- Small Island Developing States Accelerated; Modalities of Action; and
- Others

Sustainable Development and Financing Frameworks



- Countries are **signatories** to multiple development agendas.
- They need to **simultaneously implement** these commitments.
- In the era of **sustainable development**, **new generation** of development plans need to be:
 - **Resilient**,
 - **Inclusive**, and
 - **Coherent** (both **vertical** and **horizontal**).

- But the **traditional planning approaches and tools** are inadequate to design resilient and inclusive development plans.
- Hence the demand for **new planning approaches and tools** that takes into account continental and global agreements.

Questions:

- a. Do multiple development agendas speak each other?
 - b. How can these agendas be embedded into national frameworks and harmonize reporting?
 - c. How can countries leverage synergies among multiple development initiatives?
- These questions can be addressed through a **coherent integration** of multiple development agendas into national development frameworks.

- **Horizontal coherence:** Identify linkages among multiple development agendas.
- **Vertical coherence:** Assess alignment between international agendas and national/subnational priorities.
- **Internal coherence:** Are the **goals, targets and indicators** of the NDP interlinked and mutually reinforcing?
- **Prioritization and sequencing:** Where can catalytic interventions have the most impact? Not all interventions have **equal impacts**.

2. ECA's Integrated Planning and Reporting Toolkit (IPRT)



- **Mandate:** The 2016 Conference of Ministers (COM) requested ECA & AUC to develop a tool that helps align development agendas at national/subnational levels.
- **Desired attributes** of the toolkit:
 - simultaneously integrates both Agendas into NDPs with features of harmonised adaptation, progress tracking and reporting.
 - provides guidance on integrating multiple commitments and development agendas into national/subnational plans.
 - help understand relationship between different development agendas and commitments.

- What is **ECA's IPRT**?
- A tool that facilitates **alignment/integration** of A2030 and A2063 at goal, target and indicator levels (**Horizontal alignment**).
- **Simultaneously** allows for assessing the alignment of NDPs with both agendas (**Vertical alignment**).
- Assess **degree of alignment** by **sector** and **dimensions**.
- Simultaneously report on the **integration** of both agendas into NDPs.
- **Reports**: Progress review; contributions to VNRs for to the HLPF; Visualization of important aspects of the alignment process.
- **Tracks performance** of NDPs and assess gaps between actual performance and targets.
- **Identify reasons for non-integration**; a basis for providing support.
